

Timeline for the Parish of Combyne 1610 to 1956

A 17 page typescript, compiled from parish records, was included in the research material of the late Nicky Campbell, formerly of Combyne Manor, given to Lyme Regis Museum by Donald Campbell in December 2020.

Team member Richard Wells has produced this digital transcription, October 2021.

There were no transcripts of weddings due to the Civil War.

Famine, bread was made from peas and beans, because of wheat scarcity in the West Country. So many cattle had died in the wet weather that an order went out that the bodies had to be buried, wheat cost 46/8d

Walter Gregory of Axminster married Joan Wills and Phillip Baker alias Tucker married Elizabeth Moxam of Culliton

Ann Collings widow (? of Nathaniel Sen) was buried on 11.3. Lydia Cox daughter of John was buried on 10.4.

David Loring son of David and Joan and John Webber son of George and Mary were baptised

Ann Nowle was buried 12.1. Hugh Cox was buried on 8.2.

(9 baptisms in a year)

At St Pancras Sam Newbury and Mary Collins were married. The witnesses were Robert Cheek and Thomas Tillman.

Joan Hooke 24.3. was buried.

John Hoskins son of Danail and Elenor, Marey Oke daughter of John and Marey (10.7.) (Died 14.10 1830), James Powel son of James and Marey, and Cateren Cox daughter of William and Susannah were baptised.

Henry Gover married Sarah Borde, John Bridel married Joan Boals, and Thomas Bridel married Sarah Hansford.

A wall plaque in St Pancras recorded the death of Robert Cheek on October 14 aged 60.
