

St Michael's Parish Church, Lyme Regis Ancient Window Discovered in 1976

When decayed stonework was removed from the North aisle of Lyme Regis Parish Church a bricked up window was discovered. Workmen in the process of restoring many windows in the church, were putting in replacement Blue Lias stone when they made the discovery.

"The window, bricked from the outside and inside may have been eliminated many years ago when the 16th century gallery was extended" said the vicar, Reverend Peter Nicholson.
