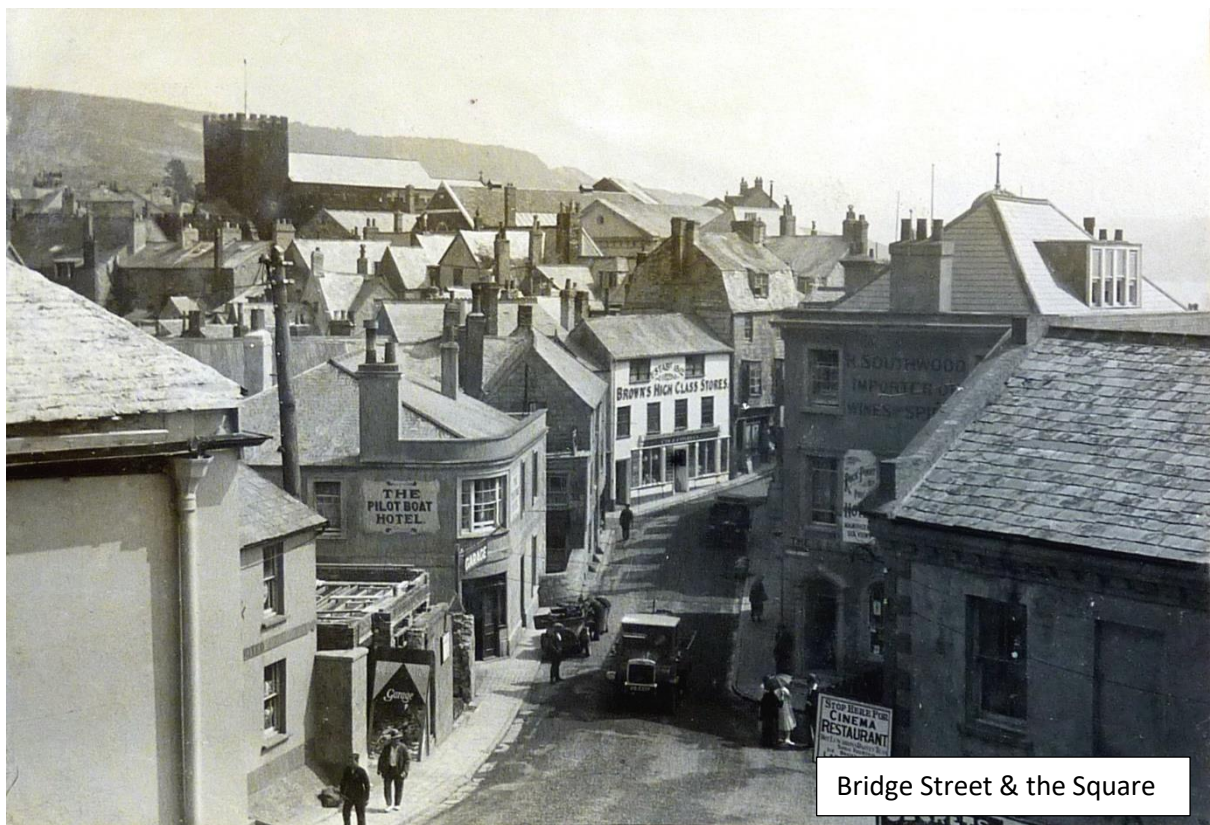
In 2011 John Collison donated a photograph album to Lyme Regis Museum.

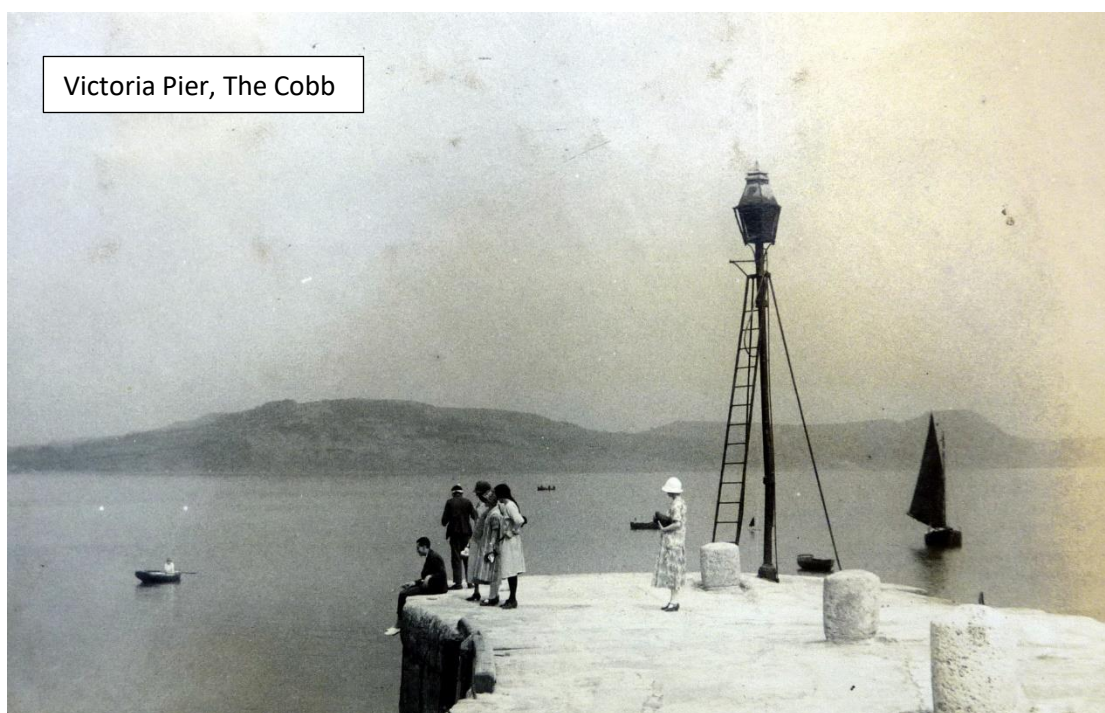

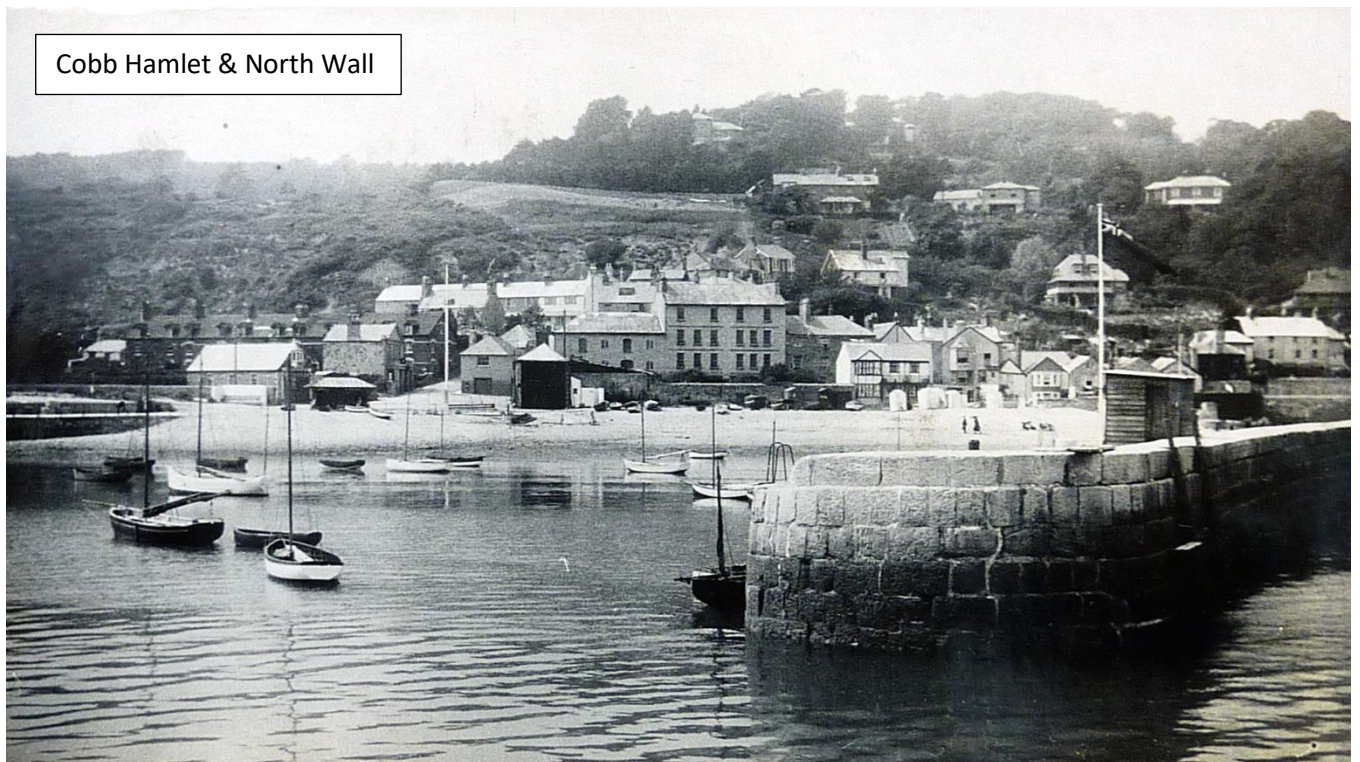

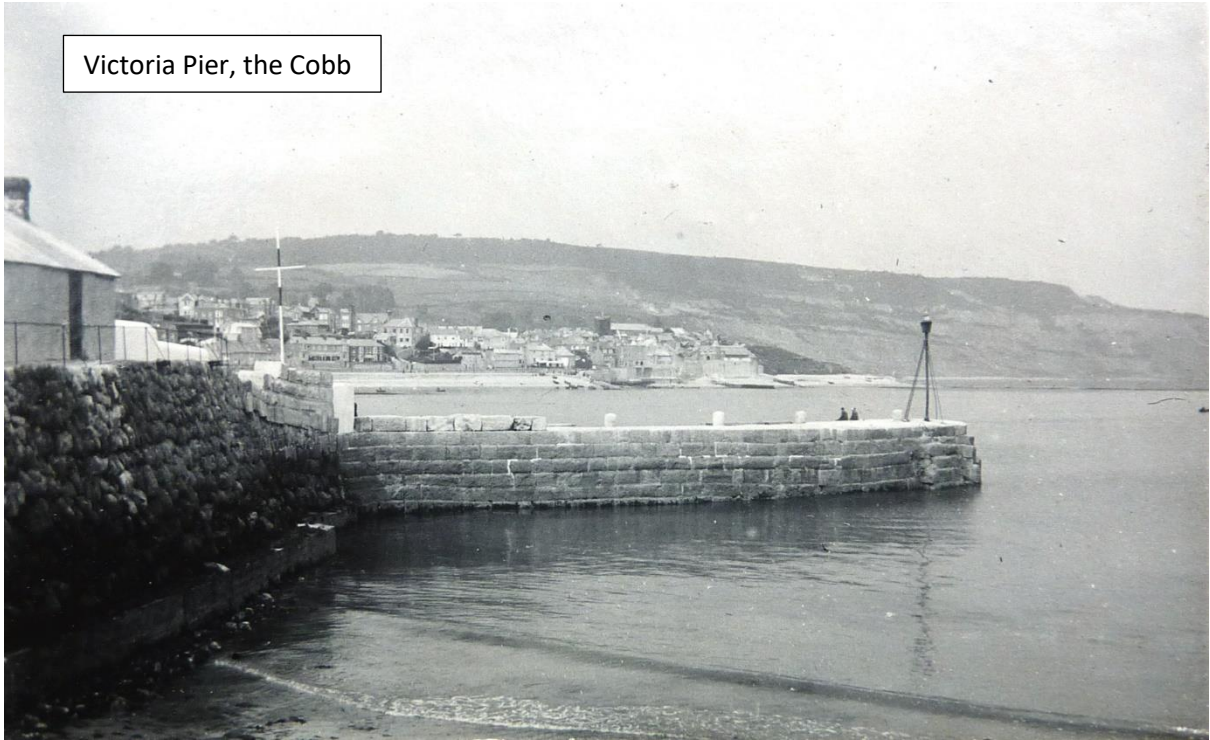

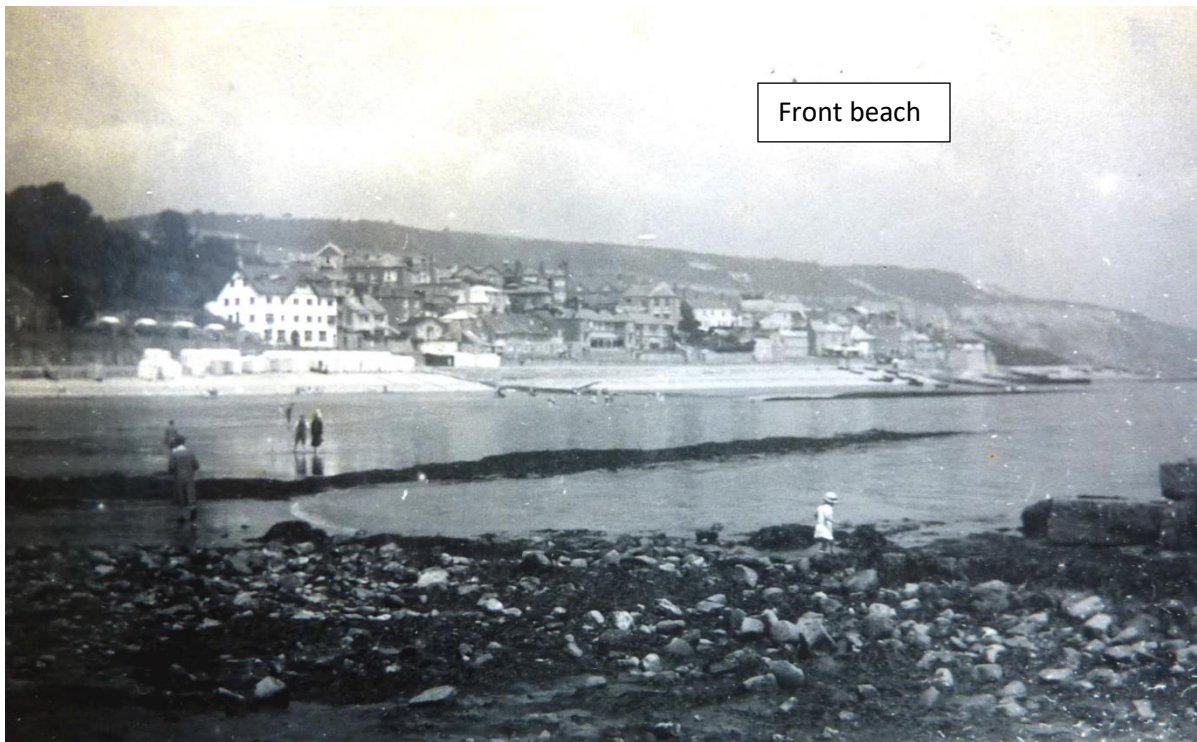
