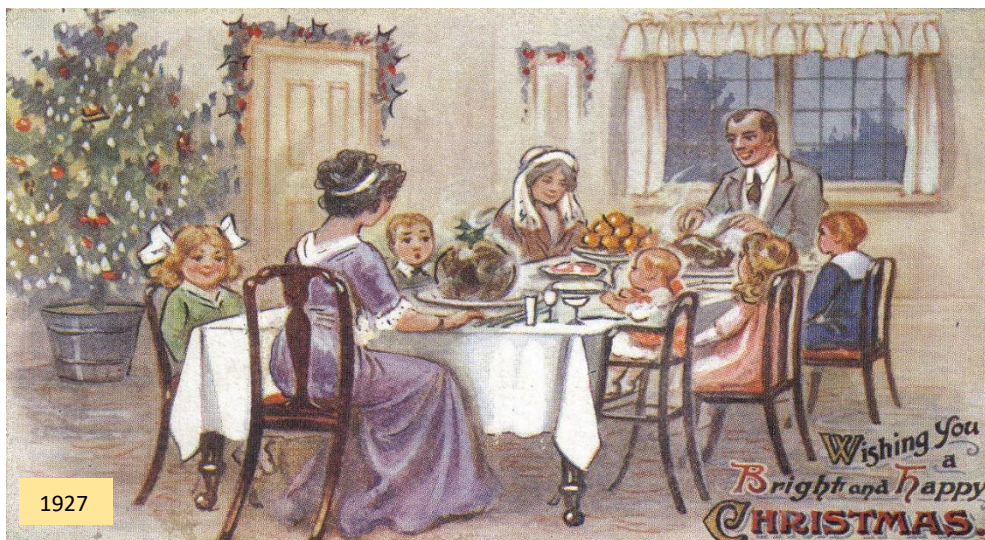


Christmas Postcards 1918-39
