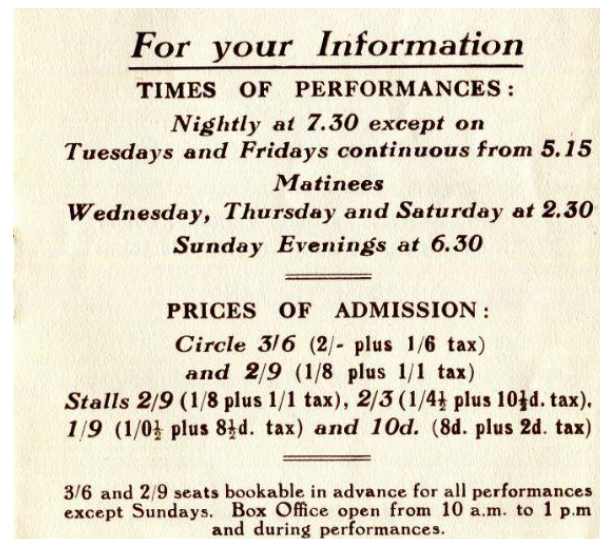
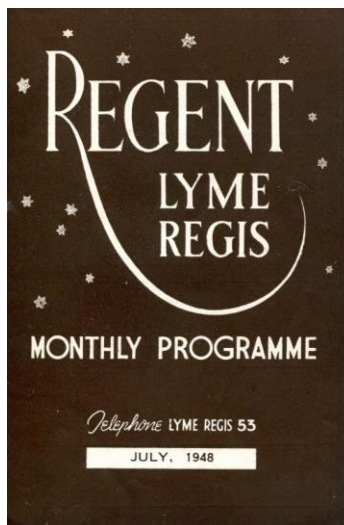

Regent Cinema, 33 Broad Street, Lyme Regis, 2005

The Regent was opened in 1937 by a local cinema operator Donald Hardy who ran it until the early 1970s. The art deco building was designed by Bristol-based architect William Henry Watkins whose other designs included the Forum in Bath. The cinema was destroyed by fire in 2016. Its future is still uncertain in 2023.

In 2017 the Museum was loaned 72 Regent Cinema programmes covering the period from July 1948 to December 1955. Details and times of the film shows are summarised here, with examples of colour and presentation.
